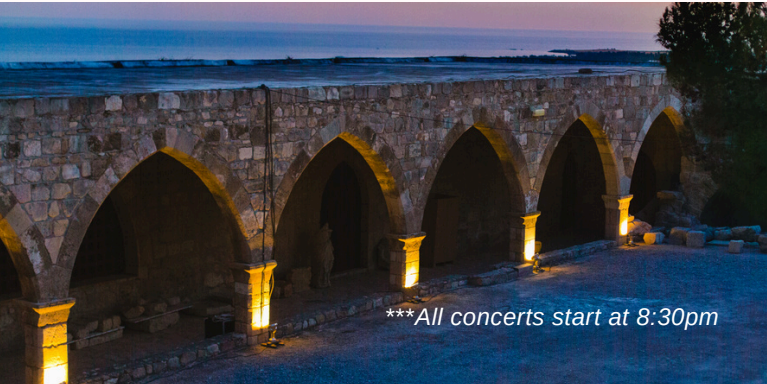

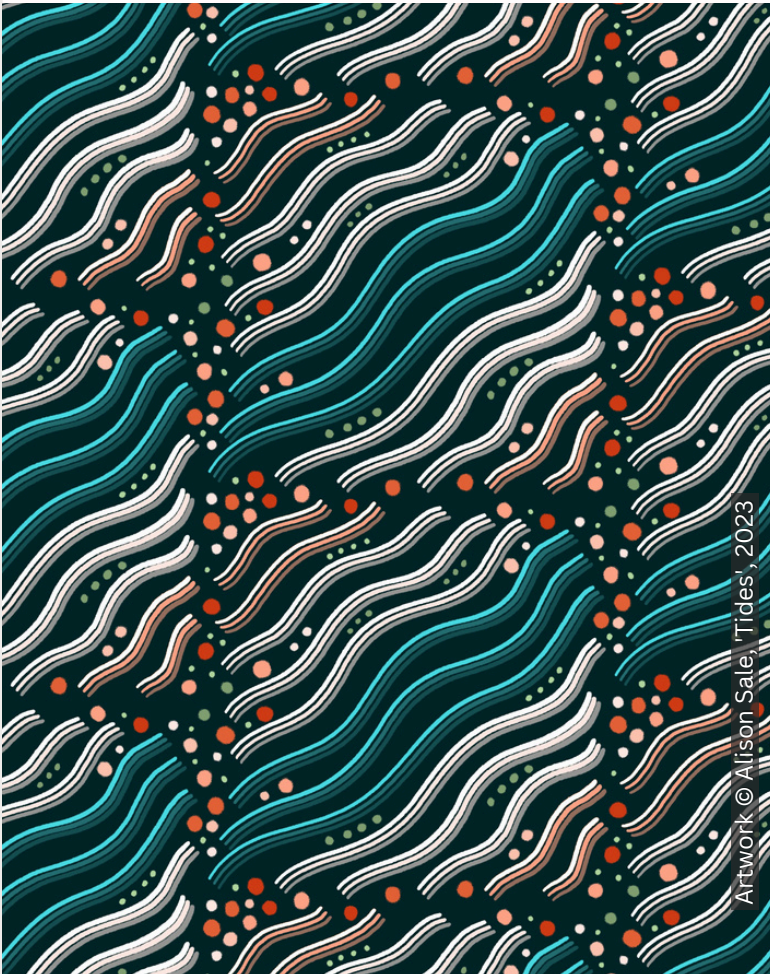

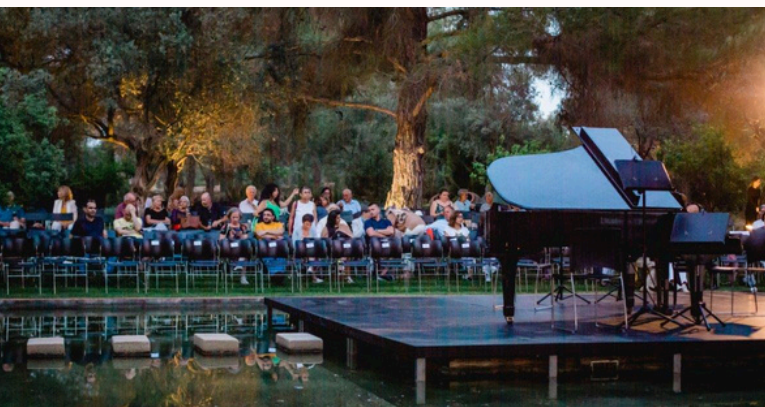


EXPERIENCE THE ENCHANTMENT OF MUSIC WITH THE WORLD'S LEADING VIRTUOSOS

The International Pharos Chamber Music Festival has become a landmark in the global classical music scene, celebrated for its artistic excellence and cultural impact. For over two decades, it has brought world-renowned soloists and ensembles to Cyprus, enriching the island's cultural life and enhancing its international profile. The Festival presents a diverse repertoire, offering audiences a dynamic and profound musical experience. With a strong commitment to community engagement, the Festival also promotes music education, offering transformative learning opportunities to students across Cyprus. Its main venue, the historic Royal Manor House of Kouklia, a UNESCO World Heritage site, provides an intimate and atmospheric setting where heritage and artistry merge.

The **24th International Pharos Chamber Music Festival** features five chamber concerts from 27 to 31 May in Kouklia, performed by 19 acclaimed international musicians. The Festival will conclude on 1 June at the Pharos Arts Foundation's open-air venue, The Olive Grove in Delikipos, with a special performance featuring four of the Festival's soloists alongside the Cyprus Youth Symphony Orchestra.

The **Royal Manor House, Kouklia** is one of the finest surviving monuments of Frankish architecture in Cyprus. The building also houses an archaeological museum, which records the rich history of human activity in the region from about 2800 BC. Palaepaphos was a city-kingdom of Cyprus and one of the most celebrated pilgrimage centres of the ancient Greek world. It was the site of the sanctuary of Aphrodite, the oldest remains of which date back to the 12th century BC. A UNESCO World Heritage site, the Royal Manor House is transformed during the International Pharos Chamber Music Festival into an intimate chamber music hall for an exceptional series of concerts.
